	opportunities have been built into the project and most training will be conducted at a detailed protected
	contact wall in one of our guest areas.

	cooperatively with all zoo staff and the variety of species on the savannah. A comprehensive understanding

	ensuring communication flows effectively from curators to zookeepers and from zookeepers to curators.

	all the goals and responsibilities of the department. The lead zookeeper is responsible for communication
	creating a cohesive team that can successfully meet team objectives. This position assists in addressing
	issues in the section and maintains consistent expectations with the keepers as established by the
	assistant curators. This position performs skilled animal husbandry, observation and enclosure
	maintenance for a variety of taxa. This position develops, maintains and advances the training and
	enrichment programs for a variety of species. This position also requires the ability to present
	demonstrations and animal talks throughout the day. Responsibilities of this position also include providing
	an excellent guest experience while providing for the care, feeding, maintenance and observation of
	animals, as well as recordkeeping and assisting with movement of animals as directed. This position also
	assists with veterinary procedures as required. Performs other duties as assigned.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities	Three years experience in the care, handling and feeding of animals in a zoological or aquarium setting is
	preferred. Experience as a team leader and experience working in or leading a formal, structured training
	program is preferred.
