Essential Functions	<p>Under the direction of the Hospital Manager, the Veterinary Technician assists the staff and veterinarians with the health care of the animal collection and oversees laboratory and clinic use, care, maintenance, cleanliness, preparedness, drug inventory and other duties as instructed by the office manager and veterinarians. Duties include assisting with treatments, surgery and anesthesia monitoring, immobilizations, necropsies, digital radiography, and laboratory procedures (parasitology, hematology, serum chemistry, cytology, serum banking, preparing samples for shipping to reference and specialty labs).</p>

Physical Requirements	<p>Good physical condition: ability to lift a minimum of 75 lbs. (i.e. feed sack) and move a minimum of 100 lbs. (i.e. hay bale). While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to stand; walk and reach with hands and arms. The employee is occasionally required to sit; climb or balance; stoop, kneel, crouch, or crawl. Vision capabilities required include close, distance and peripheral vision, depth perception and ability to adjust focus. Evaluating animal health, diet, or environment requires hearing and smell. Interaction with guests and animals requires talking and hearing. While performing the duties of this job, the employee is occasionally exposed to wet or humid conditions (non-weather) and outdoor weather conditions. The employee is occasionally in direct contact with exotic animals and is occasionally exposed to work near moving mechanical parts; work in high, precarious places. The noise level in the work environment varies. Occasional loud noises from visitors, animals or equipment are experienced.</p>
